1. **Copy** the new words and **study** them (see extra file "New words" below the weekly plan).
2. Choose 5 of the new words and **write gap sentences** for your partner.
3. **Read** these chapters
 - 15: *Hunger Pains* (p. 96)
 - 16: *Rowdy Gives Me Advice About Love* (p. 106)
 - 17: *Dance, Dance, Dance* (p. 109)
4. Share **what happens** in these chapters. Take turns! 
5. *Option 1:* (100-200 words) 
Write **a diary entry for Penelope** in which she talks about her feelings about Arnold Spirit.
- Option 2:* (100-200 words) 
Imagine the following scenario and write **a dialogue**.
 - a) Junior speaks to Gordy about bulimia without mentioning Penelope.
 - b) Junior tells his parents about his experience in the school bathroom.
