Level 1

2. (partner work ©©) Write down 5 new English words **without a vowel** (e.g. "public" would become "pblc"). Can your partner guess them correctly, make a sentence with them and translate them into German? ©

3. (group/partner work ©©) Find three different partners and **interview them about their summer holidays**. Form proper questions first (at least 5! Write them down!) and take some notes of their answers.

4. (partner work ©©) Remember the **book rallye** you had to do in form 7 & 8? This year create your own one about Lighthouse 6 with at least 10 questions/tasks! Then **exchange** them with a partner and try to solve them.

Example: What is Unit 3 about? / Where can you find the irregular words? (etc.)

5. (partner work C) **Talk** to someone you do not know that well or don't talk to a lot and discuss at least three of these questions. Try to speak for as long as you can! C
